





## Equifax Customer Service

As a credit reference agency we collect public and credit data to produce credit reports and credit scores. These are then used by responsible lenders to make decisions about whether to give someone credit. But did you know you also have the right to access your personal credit information?

## Your statutory rights include the right to:

- Receive a copy of your Statutory Credit Report within 7 working days of Equifax receiving your application and payment
- Dispute inaccurate information on your credit file
- Have errors corrected within 28 days.

Under the Data Protection Act (1998) Equifax is permitted by law to charge you **£2** for each request you make for your **Statutory Credit Report.**
